4. About part time jobs

Part-time work is prohibited for Technical Intern Trainees.

The first year of resident status is “Technical Intern Trainee No. 1”, the second year and third year are “Technical Intern Trainee No. 2”

Receiving money at other offices or stores is regarded as a work activity and not only yourself but also the company / union is given penalty. In addition, it will be an off-training activity and might go back to your home country.

5. About earthquake
